ATLANTA: Mornings in Marietta are getting a flavorful upgrade as **Ike's Café & Grill** introduces a new breakfast menu at its Cherokee Street location, inviting guests to start the day with a mix of West African-inspired favorites and classic breakfast staples.

Available daily from **7 to 11 a.m.**, the new menu showcases the bold, comforting flavors that have become synonymous with Ike's while offering something for every kind of breakfast craving. Guests can pair their meal with selections from Ike's premium African coffee program, making the Marietta location a destination for a leisurely breakfast, a morning pick-me-up or a casual start to the day.

The breakfast menu includes dishes such as the **Agege Breakfast Sandwich** (\$10), featuring soft, slightly sweet Agege-style bread stuffed with fluffy scrambled eggs, sautéed peppers and onions, and a choice of protein; **Plantain & Eggs** (\$12), pairing sweet, caramelized fried plantains with eggs scrambled with tomatoes, onions and peppers; and **Boiled Yam and Egg Stew** (\$14), featuring tender boiled yam served alongside a rich, slow-simmered tomato and pepper egg stew. More traditional breakfast options include the **Classic Breakfast** (\$13), **Big Ike's Breakfast** (\$17) and **Chicken & Waffles** (\$16).

Additional offerings include **French Toast** (\$12), the **Toast Breakfast Sandwich** (\$9) and **Shrimp and Grits** (\$18) with a savory pepper and onion gravy, giving guests a range of options that reflect both Ike's West African roots and familiar breakfast favorites.

Located at **724 Cherokee St.**, the Marietta restaurant opened in spring 2026 as Ike's expanded its presence in the Atlanta area. The location joins Ike's Norcross flagship restaurant and its additional location in the West End, continuing the brand's growth across the metro Atlanta community.

Whether guests are craving a hearty plate, a quick breakfast sandwich or a taste of Ike's Nigerian-inspired flavors, the new menu offers a fresh reason to make breakfast part of the Ike's experience.

With both indoor and outdoor seating, the full-service location also offers a casual setting for morning meetings, coffee catch-ups, and working breakfasts and is open seven days a week (Monday-Saturday 7 a.m.-10 p.m. + Sundays noon to 9 p.m.).
